The scholarships will be awarded to a student who will be attending any accredited higher education institution in the United States next year.

The scholarships will be awarded to graduating students residing in the Hendersonville area who are currently attending Beech, Hendersonville, Station Camp, Merrol Hyde or Pope John Paul II High Schools or who are home schooled.

It is required that the completed applications include:

- -copy of their high school transcript, showing ACT scores
- -copy of their parents' or guardians' latest signed IRS From 1040 (black out SSNs)
- -one letter of recommendation from teachers
