The scholarships will be awarded to a student who will be attending any accredited higher education institution in the United States next year.

The scholarships will be awarded to graduating students residing in the Hendersonville area who are currently attending Beech, Hendersonville, Station Camp, Merrol Hyde, Liberty Creek or Pope John Paul II High Schools or who are home schooled.

Students are to submit their completed application to the guidance office at their school no later than Thursday, March 7, 2024. A member of the Club will pick up the applications from the guidance office on Thursday, March 14, 2024. **No late applications will be accepted.**

It is required that the completed applications include:

- copy of their high school transcript, showing ACT scores
- copy of their parents' or guardians' latest signed IRS Form 1040 (black out SSNs)
- one letter of recommendation from teachers

Students may attach additional pages if there is not enough space on the application form.
