The scholarships will be awarded to a student who will be attending any accredited higher education institution in the United States next year.

The scholarships will be awarded to graduating students who are currently attending Beech, Hendersonville, Station Camp, Merrol Hyde, Liberty Creek, or Pope John Paul II High Schools or are home-schooled, and whom reside in the city of Hendersonville or **have** a Hendersonville or 37075 address

Students are to submit their completed application to the guidance office at their school no later than Monday, March 17th, 2025. A member of the club will pick up the applications from the guidance office on Friday, March 21, 2025. **No late applications will be accepted. ***Please note this year, the application pages must be one sided with NO staples.**

It is required that the completed applications include:

- copy of their high school transcripts, showing ACT scores
- copy of their parents' or guardians' latest signed IRS form 1040 (black out SSNs)
- one letter of recommendation from teachers

Students may attach additional pages if there is not enough space on the application form.

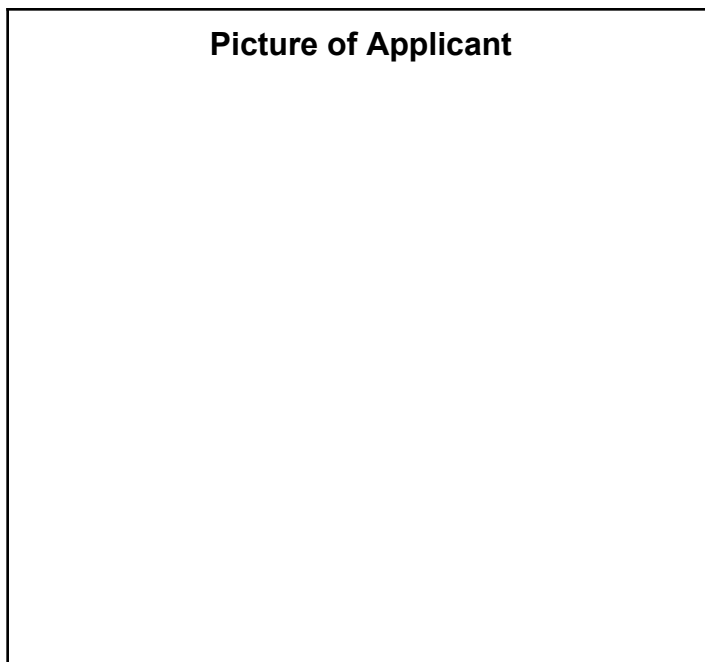
